

How to play Pete's Quiz



Gather your friends and family for Pete's quiz and have lots of laughs!

How many players can I have?

As many as you like! As long as you have a 'Quiz Master' and at least one other player. We suggest four or more players if you can.

What do I need to play the game?

You'll need are all the letters of the alphabet, something to put them in, a pen and an answer sheet!

Scrabble pieces are great to use but if you don't have them, you can write the individual letters on pieces of paper. Once you have your letters pop them into a bowl or a gift bag you might have around the house.

How do I play Pete's Quiz?

Firstly, print of the answer sheets, you'll need one for each player. The answer sheets give you the topics that you'll use to play each round. You can play four rounds in total on each sheet.

Secondly, you'll need to assign a 'Quiz Master'! This person will pull a letter from the bowl or bag at the start of each round.

Once a letter has been drawn, the 'Quiz Master' sets a timer for 5 minutes. You'll have 5 minutes think of an answer for each topic that begins with that letter. For example, if the topic is 'Boy's name' and the letter is 'E' you could write down Eric. Do the same for all topics until you have an answer for each one or the time runs out!

How does the game work?

1. Once the 5 minutes is up everyone puts their pens down.
2. Choose one player to start sharing their answer for the first topic. Go around in a circle until everyone has shared their answers.
3. Continue the topics one at a time until all topic answers have been shared for that particular letter.

How to score each round

The scoring is simple but is the best part of the game!

- If you match the 'Quiz Masters' answer you and the 'Quiz Master' get 3 points
- If you have an answer that no one else has you get 2 points
- If you have the same answer as another player, you get 1 point

At the end of each round count your total score and the player with the most points wins that round!
